Member Release and Waiver of Liability, Assumption of Risk, and Indemnity Agreement

In participation I expressly assume any and all risks of injury or loss and agree to indemnify the members, coaches, and Vermillion Valley Equine Center and its staff harmless from and against all claims including for any injury or loss suffered during or in connection with training, practice, competition, or member event, whether or not such injury, claim or loss resulted directly or indirectly from the negligent acts or omissions of said training, practice, competition, or member event.

I acknowledge that under Kansas law, there is no liability for an injury to or the death of a participant in domestic animal activities as described above. You are assuming the risk of participating in this domestic animal activity. K.S.A. 60-4001 through 60-4004. Inherent risks of domestic animal activities include, but shall not be limited to: (1) The propensity of a domestic animal to behave in ways, i.e. running, bucking, biting, kicking, shying, stumbling, rearing, falling or stepping on, that may result in an injury, harm or death to persons on or around them; (2) The unpredictability of a domestic animal's reaction to such things as sounds, sudden movement and unfamiliar objects, persons or other animals; (3) certain hazards such as surface and subsurface conditions; (4) collision with other domestic animals or objects, and (5) the potential of a participant to act in a negligent manner that may contribute to injury to the participant or others, such as falling to maintain control over the domestic animal or not acting within such participant's ability.

By signing this form, I hereby acknowledge my complete understanding, agreement and consent to my presence and participation in the Equestrian at K-State sports club member activities, without restriction, without liability to other members, coaches, and Vermillion Valley Equine Center and staff or agents, and with full knowledge and understanding of the disclosures, waivers, and releases herein.
